500 dignitaries across the world including clergy academics, professionals, scientists, researchers, artistes and civil society leaders was organized by parliamentarian Ven. Atureliye Ratana Thera and had Indian Minister of EGC and Water Resour-

ces Dr. Nitin Raut as the chief guest.
